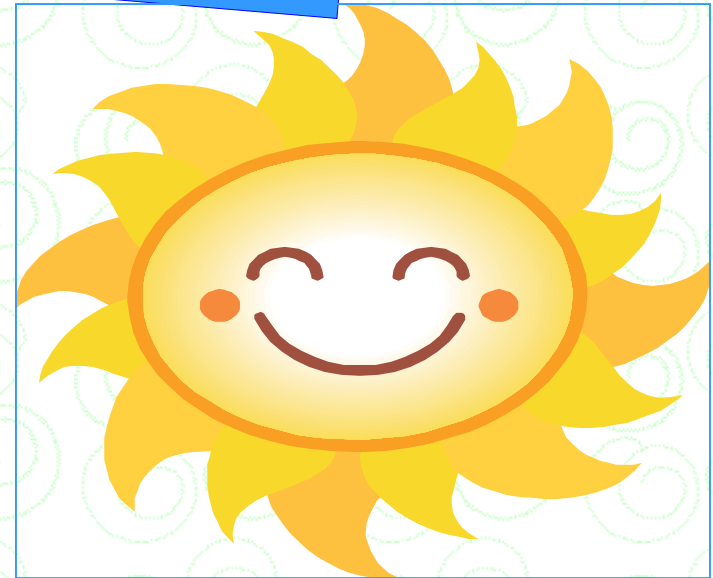

Counselor in Training (C. I. T.)

Day Camp Information

Thank God It's Summer! Is the JCS Advantage Summer Day Camp 2009 theme.

This year we have blended learning and play in a new and affordable way. Registration is \$35.00 and \$15.00 for each additional child. Registration is non-refundable. A new blue emergency form and a copy of immunization record is due with registration. Friday field trip shirts are required if going on a field trip and can be purchased for \$10.00.

Each weekly session is \$ 155.00 and \$ 30.00 for field trips. If you need occasional care, Drop In care is available and is \$55.00 per day. Payments must be prepaid two weeks in advance on Friday's. If payment is not received two weeks ahead of time parent's will be charged a \$15.00 late registration fee per child for each week and the camper will not be allowed to attend on Monday without payment.

Breakfast is available at a cost of \$2.50.

Campers must pack a lunch daily.

A morning and an afternoon snack will be provided. Campers may bring extra money if they desire to purchase additional snacks.

Summer Camp will open at 6:30 am and close promptly at 6:00 pm. A late fee will be assessed in the amount of \$5.00 the first minute late and \$1.00 each additional minute and is due and payable the next morning. There are no additional extended care charges this year. You may use the program any of the hours that we are open. So go ahead and mix and match our programs to fit your families needs!

JCS Advantage reserves the right to cancel any classes for any reason. In the event that JCS Advantage cancels a class a full refund will be given or every effort will be made to place your camper in a different class.

Refund policy: You may request a refund up to seven days prior to a class beginning, after that refunds will not be given.

Classes are filled on a first come basis. Some classes fill up quickly so please do not delay on registering.

Camp Descriptions

Visual Arts-Using a variety of art medium such as watercolors, pencils and paints campers will expand their artistic understanding of composition, perspective color theory and blending. From stunning self portraits to comic strips we will create masterpieces for all to enjoy!

Technology-using a wide array of software, games and applications each camper will work to create a computer generated presentation using video, still frames and moving images. Imaginations run wild as they learn communication using computers.

Dance Academy-Embrace your inner pop star while learning the latest dance moves! Campers will choreograph their own routines. It's fast moving and challenging but appropriate of all ages and no dance experience is necessary!

Claymation-Do you wonder how movies like Chicken Run and Wallace & Gromitt were made? Well, you can discover the fun of stop motion animation for yourself! Collaborate with a team of peers to create an exciting animated short film.

Fun Brain-Review academic subjects in a fun and energetic environment. Campers will use their critical thinking skills with interactive games and group activities.

Film Institute-This Camp will challenge young people to tell a story through film. Campers will learn the fundamentals of directing, writing, editing & cinematography.

Trendsetters Fashion Design– Experience bringing designs to life from concept to the Catwalk. Create formal, casual and costume designs. Each camper will be a part of a group that will collaborate to create looks that are trendsetting.

Puppet Masters-Join us as we explore puppeteer techniques. From shadow puppets and Marionettes to hand held puppets. Design your own puppet to be featured in a Puppet Masters performance.

Studio Art-Campers will create 3 dimensional sculptures, canvas pieces and digital art using unconventional and traditional art materials.

Camp Rock– Hannah Montana, High School Musical and the Jonas Brothers won't have anything on you! Unleash your inner rock star as we sing, dance and dive into performing arts! Work on a solo project or collaborate with friends to combine your talents and dazzle the audience in a live recital!

Camp Descriptions

Scrap booking– Preserving Memories will be a blast for each camper as they learn the joy of Scrap booking! **This class has a \$10.00 materials fee per camper.

Language Arts- Take an introductory look at languages of the world. Students will work at their pace and develop the ability in a dialect of their choice; playing games and learning phrases to build their vocabulary and gain confidence.

Theatre Works– This fun and energetic class will bring out the drama in us as we explore the inner working of being on stage. Children will experience theatre from all points of view. They will learn improv, casting, hair, makeup, set design, acting and much more!

Secret Agent Camp-Collect clues, investigate a crime scene and solve a case. Become an eagle crime fighter and earn your badge during secret agent camp! Campers will comb through evidence in the CSI lab!

Social Studies-Study the lives and customs of people throughout history and find out how their lives affect the world. Campers will enhance their understanding of the world around them in art, literature, academics, music and sports!

Model Making– Campers will construct different models, building kites, wood works and even a soap box car! Campers will draft a blue print, design and build their structures.

Fun & Fit– In this camp campers will get the exercise they need to grow healthy, strong and fit all while having a blast in an exciting, non competitive social atmosphere. We enjoy kickboxing, aerobics, high energy dance and all star sports.

Movie Makeup Academy-Come learn the secrets of creating movie magic! Under The Sea– Is the summer heat too much for you? Journey with us as we discover the mysteries of the deep blue sea. Discover facts about coral reefs and sea life. While making fun crafts and playing water games.

Math Madness-Campers will improve problem solving skills as they review and explore new areas in math at their own pace. This class is especially designed to allow campers to keep their minds sharp and prepare them for the next school year.

Culinary Institute-We are serving up delicious culinary delights from around the world. Children will learn kitchen safety, cooking techniques and scrumptious recipes as they cook and eat cultural dishes. Bon Appetite!*** This camp has a \$10.00 materials fee.

All Stars Sports & Water Play– This camp is designed to develop each child's team skills at an age appropriate level. Children will participate in group games such as broom hockey, basketball, soccer, flag football and water games to keep cool.
