

RE-REGISTRATION FOR 2008-2009

(Only Current Students of Joy Christian School)

What is re-registration? Each year currently enrolled students must re-register for the upcoming school year. This is done to assist the school in proper planning, hiring of staff, purchasing of materials and preparing classrooms. **You must complete and return this form for your child to be re-registered for the 2008-2009 school year. If something changes and you are unable to attend, please complete withdraw paperwork in order for the school to process paperwork appropriately.**

Please return this form and the re-registration fee on or before February 19, 2008. **After that date, others will be invited to enroll and your child's place in the class may not be available.** We continue to experience high enrollment, and it's anticipated most classes will fill quickly due to area growth and the forward movement of the high school.

All returning students must have all records complete by June 1st and pay the first month's tuition by June 20th in order to retain a place in the class. A review of all students is conducted annually to determine their eligibility for the upcoming year.

There are three steps to reserve a place in the class:

1. Pay the registration fee and return this form by February 19, 2008. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.
2. Complete *Enrollment and Tuition Payment Agreement Form*.
3. Pay the first month's tuition for the 2008-09 school year by the 20th of June.

Tuition may be paid annually, by semester or in 11 monthly installments with FACTS Tuition Management Company beginning in June. If you choose to pay through monthly installments, FACTS charges an annual service fee. Monthly installments may be made by EFT (electronic funds transfer), or credit card.

Registration Fee: \$200 per returning student – after May 1st, it becomes \$250. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable for any reason. Registration fee for new students: \$400

We as a family will...

1. ... support the mission, vision, and the core values of Joy Christian School.
2. ...understand that Bible Study, a weekly chapel service, memorizing parts of the Bible and a Christian environment are an integral part of the school.
3. ...agree that if there are any concerns with the school, we attempt to resolve them through The appropriate channels one step at a time: talking to the teacher, then the Principal and finally through the Principal to the Director. If for any reason we are unable to find resolution, it may be in the best interest to all parties that the school withdraws the child so the situation remains amicable.
4. ...be open to understanding a wellness approach for the whole child and apply that understanding to the best of our ability.
- 5...agree as a condition of enrollment to pay the tuition and fees. We understand that these fees are due and payable in order for our child(ren) to remain in the school. We understand that if the balance is delinquent in excess of 30 days, and an acceptable alternative has not been approved by the school administration, our child(ren) will not be permitted to return to school until all delinquent obligations are paid in full. Records and report cards will not be released unless a child's balance is paid in full. We understand that the registration fees are non-refundable/non-transferable so long as an application is under consideration or has been accepted by the school.
